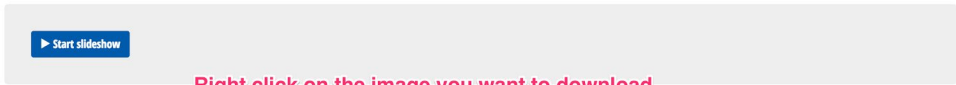
1. Click on the category in the left column to view the images

The graphic is now yours.



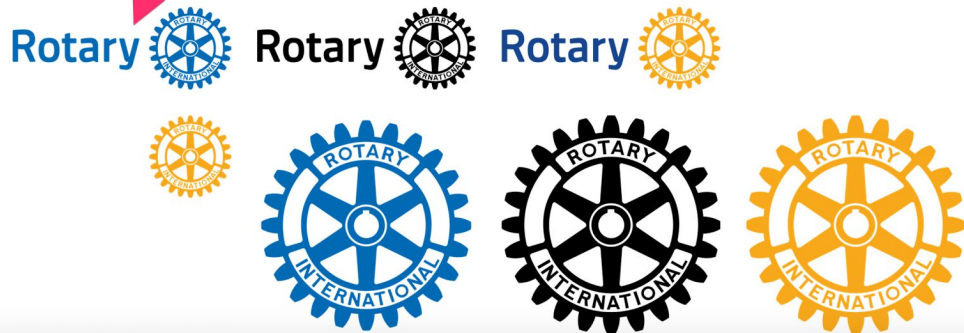

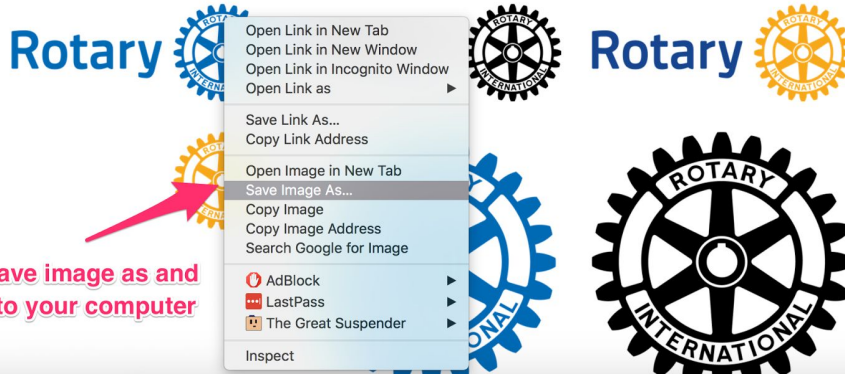
